

Nulhegan Confluence Hut And Trails Map and Directions



The hut is off Route 105, 13.5 miles east of Island Pond (2.6 miles west of Bloomfield), near the confluence of the Nulhegan River and its' East Branch.

Coming from the west: Take Route 105 from Island Pond. After 10.8 miles, you will pass the Nulhegan Basin Visitor Center. The road will descend a hill, cross the river, and then descend another hill. Look for a gravel parking area in a meadow on the right, just passed a dilapidated cabin. If you cross over the East Branch, you've gone too far.

Coming from the east: From Bloomfield, take Route 105 west for 2.6 miles. Pass over the East Branch of the Nulhegan River and by the East Branch Road on your right. The parking area and path to the hut will be in the meadow on the left.

Parking is also available off the East Branch Road, on the left. This lot is often more regularly plowed in the winter.
